Bars of Soap



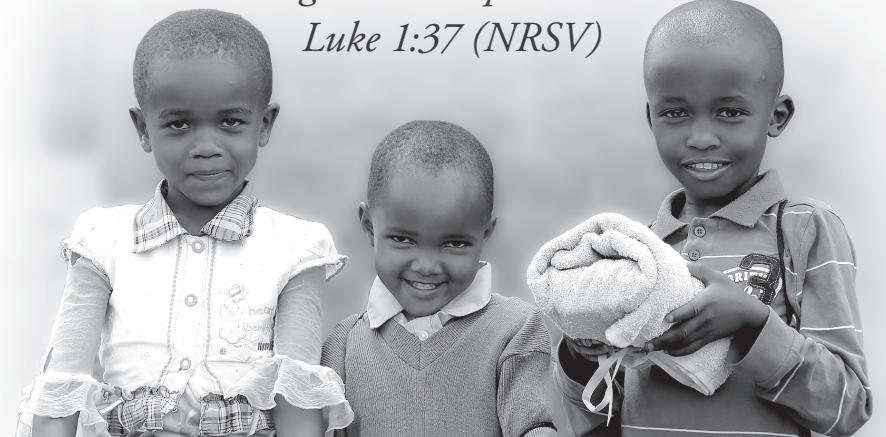

Students at ELIMAA School near Arusha, Tanzania, received LWR Personal Care Kits at a distribution organized by the school in November 2015.
